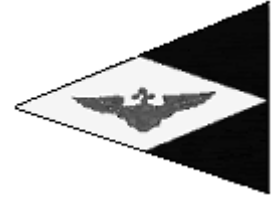




# BIKNI REGATTA

## 24 July 2010

### NOTICE OF RACE



Organized by Navy Yacht Club Pensacola

**Notice: Check this site before the race as oil spill conditions could cause postponement until a later date.**

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing including US sailing Prescriptions (hereinafter called the RRS), the current Pensacola Bay General Sailing Instructions including amendments thereto, if any.
- 1.2 Yachts leaving the course before finishing are requested to notify the RC on the course.

#### 2. Classes

- 2.1 The regatta will be open to three classes: Spinnaker PHRF, Non-Spinnaker PHRF and cruiser. The race committee may split a class if the number of entrants justifies it.

#### 3. Eligibility and Entry.

- 3.1 At least one half of the crew onboard each yacht must be female and each female counted toward this one-half requirement must have attained her 5<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to the day of race. A female must helm each yacht from the preparatory signal of her class until she finishes.
- 3.2 An entry form must be completed and submitted to the RC. Forms are available on the NYCP web site ([www.navyypsyc.org](http://www.navyypsyc.org)). Fill in all blanks and submit electronically, by 0800, Saturday, 24 July.
  - a. Forms will be available at NYCP on the day of the race during registration.
  - b. The race committee prior to first preparatory signal will accept on-the-water registrations.
  - c. The entry fee is \$40. U.S. Sailing members will receive a discount of \$5. This fee should accompany the entry form, or if entering via the web site, should be paid to the RC during Registration.

5. Starting area, Races and courses.
  - 5.1 For those who do not attend the skippers meeting, contact the RC on channel 72 for location. There will be one race, the distance of which will be approximately 10 to 12 miles. Government marks and/or dropped marks may be used.
6. Sailing Instructions.
  - 6.1 The SI and entry forms will be available on the Navy website [www.navyppnsyc.org](http://www.navyppnsyc.org) and at registration.
7. Low point scoring system of Appendix A4 of the RRS will be used. There are no throw out races.
8. Trophies
  - 8.1 There will be "take home" trophies for the first three places in each class. There will also be a trophy for the highest scoring yacht which has an all female crew.
9. Social
  - 9.1 July 24<sup>th</sup>: Everyone is invited to Navy Yacht Club after the race for refreshments.
