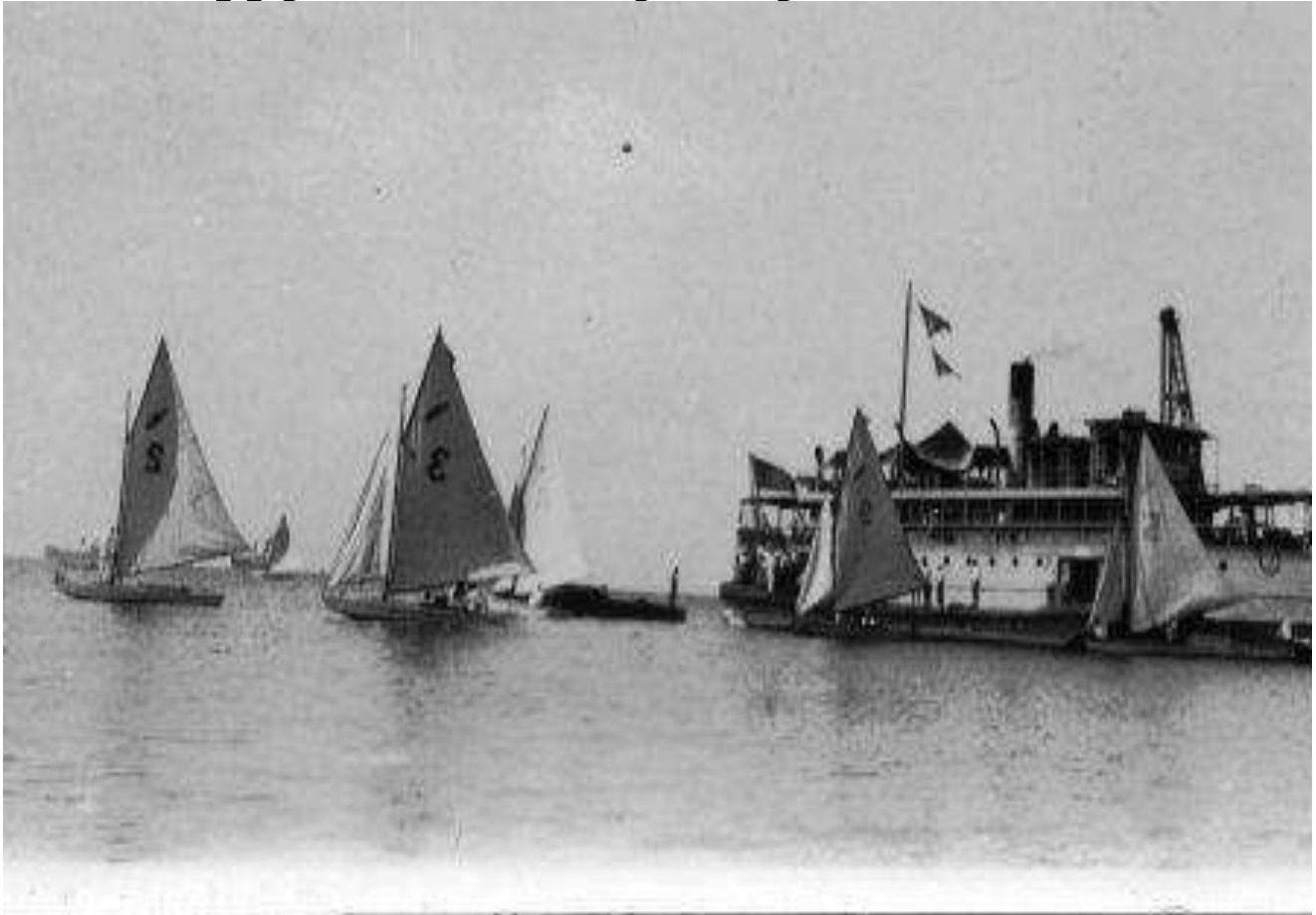

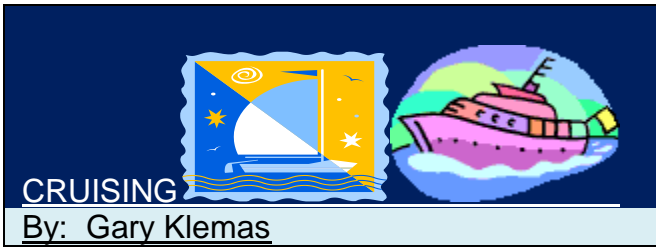

NYCP SHIPS STORE

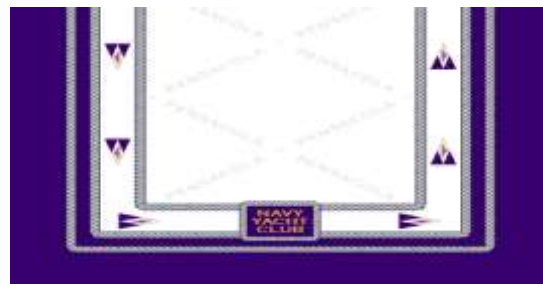
Helping support our Club by your purchases will allow us to increase and diversify our Ships Store inventory! Many thanks for all of your support and all of your very positive input!

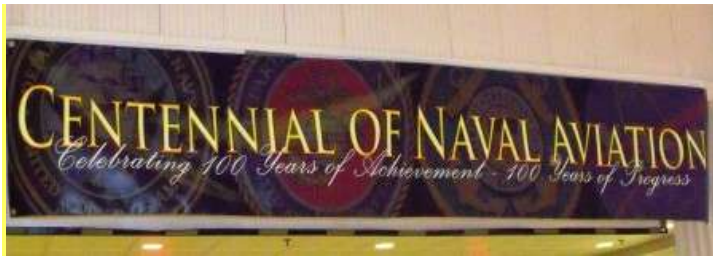
