## Cruise Capers

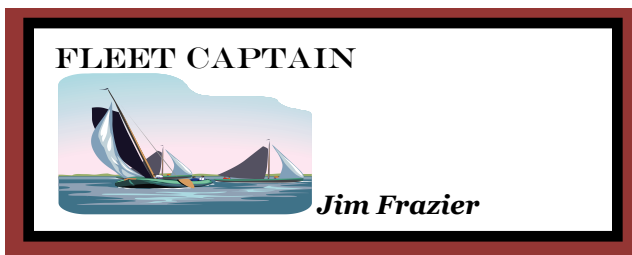

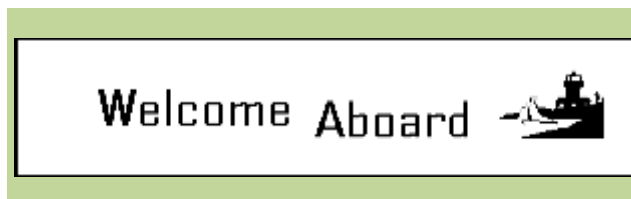
